Can be adapted for Diamonte (seven lines – nouns, adjectives, participles) & Parts of Speech (five lines - article, noun, adjective, conjunction, adjective, verb conjunction, verb, adverb, noun) according to required pattern)



CINQUAIN - Add details... rest of lines, different words – Does it make sense?

One word about topic (or two syllables)

Three verbs describing topic (or six syllables)

Four-word phrase telling about topic (or eight syllables)

One word synonym for topic (or two syllables)

Topic: *Winter activities*

Activity	Words that start with the activity letters	
S K I I N G	H O C K E Y	snow, sometimes, silly, super knee, keep, knight, kite, kind it, ice, inside, igloo island, indigo, in nice, nasty, not, night good, gone, glad, great



EXAMPLE: Acrostic Poem—

Using the words from your poem words, add the first word, then make the line into a phrase that says something about the topic

Snow is needed.

Kind of like skating,

It just requires longer flatter blades and poles.

Ice is not good,

Not comfortable when you fall.

Great to get to the bottom of the hill.

**Edit – Does it meet format requirements?
Is everything spelled correctly?**
